We last wrote in November with information about the enabling and early work taking place on site in preparation for a Ministerial decision and ‘green light’ for the NRC – which is expected in the Spring. We are pleased to say that these preliminary activities were completed as planned and the site now benefits from its new entrance road and

‘bellmouth’ onto the Melton Road (A6006) – as well as its temporary access onto Leake Lane.

In January, the IHP contractor team made good progress with the early ‘bulk earthwork’ which involved removal of topsoil, site levelling, general ground preparation, and establishing a new swale and balancing pond



Working on Saturdays
