Dear Victoria,

We have collated the results from the surveys which were undertaken for the full week from 5th April 2024 to the 15th April 2024

On Vinetree Terrace and Old Parsonage Lane, Hoton we measured the speeds of vehicles and the number of vehicles using these roads. The map attached shows where speed readings were taken, the results of which are summarised below:

<u>Traffic speeds</u> (the 85th percentile is the speed that 85% of the vehicles are travelling at or below this speed) this is the data taken between 0700-1900hrs

These speeds show a very good compliance with the 30mph speed limit

The data shows that the majority of vehicle movements are along Old Parsonage Lane, which we would expect as there are accesses for businesses off of Old Parsonage Lane, such as the kennels. This will generate more traffic with clients and employees accessing and egressing using this road. The peak traffic flows are almost consistently between 7am and 8am and 5pm to 6pm

Vinetree Terrace has less drivers using it and there is very little correlation between the peak traffic counts and the times. If there was a significant number of vehicles rat running then the number of drivers using Vinetree Terrace would be higher and more similar to Old Parsonage Lane. This is not the case, this is supported by there being very little correlation between the peaks for Vinetree Terrace which vary through the week.

Given the above findings we would not be able to justify any further action.
