Village Mailing List	Notices were put on the Parish Council website, Facebook and the village WhatsApp group about the mailing list. Several responses have ben received and new ones are received each day. Posters are also to be displayed on the notice boards around the village along with the agenda for this meeting. Distribute a letter to residents on Vinetree Terrace and Old Parsonage Lane	The letters is being distributed and responses will be collated and sent to all Councillors once received.	
Black box data	LCC Highways were contacted to ask if the Parish Council would be able to receive a copy of the data. No response has been received yet. I will chase them soon if no response is received.	
Reservoir Planning Application	Hamish was contacted to request further details which we sent through and these were distributed to all Councillors. No further action is required.	
Damaged tree at the entrance to the playground	This has been reported to LCC to find out if the tree is one of those that they are responsible for. The individual who deals with the trees is now out of the office until the 11 <sup>th</sup> September.  LCC visited the site and confirmed the tree does not belong to the Parish Council but that of neighbouring land.	The owner of the land was identified and they have been written to. It has since been confirmed someone will look at the tree and take action in the early new year.
Highways Membership Fund	LCC Highways has suggested a new VAS. It was agreed at a previous Parish Council meeting that this should go ahead.  A recent update was received stating there had been a delay with the installation due to an internal misunderstanding. We are waiting to receive an installation date.	We are still no further forward with this but an update has been requested again.
Unsuitable for HGV Road Sign at the entrance to Vinetree Terrace/Old Parsonage Lane Traffic	LCC Highways were contacted about our concerns with this. They replied stating they felt the signage was adequate and that they believe HGV's won't use these roads. Ring Doorbell evidence was submitted.	LCC were contacted once again and confirmation has been sought as to what evidence they require.

	LCC responded saying the Ring Doorbell evidence doesn't prove anything and that it is probably locals using these roads as a cut through and nothing they can do about this.	
Storage Shed at Village Hall	I made contact with the village hall to ask them about the possibility of a storage shed to store the Parish Councils gardening equipment etc. I have looked at the storage shed and it is appropriate for the storage of the Parish Councils items.	Mel has not yet placed the items in the storage shed but hopes to do it soon.
